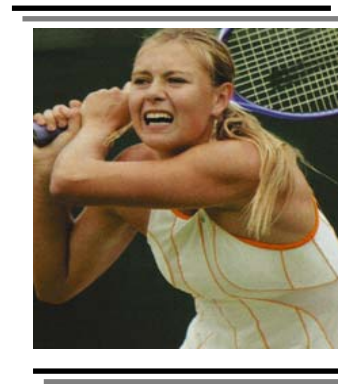
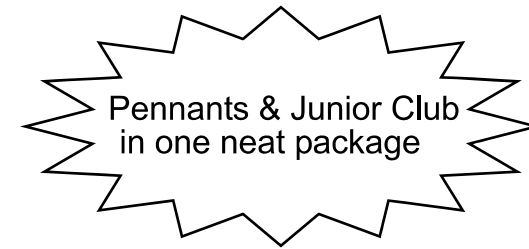

Dear Player,

If you love to play matches and like being part of a team, then you might like to think about playing pennant tennis for East Fremantle Lawn Tennis Club.

Clubs are now beginning to sort out their teams as they need to be submitted to Tennis West by 4th September. It is imperative that players sign up **now** so the Club can submit the appropriate number of teams for each age group. If you would like to be in a team, **now** is the time to apply.

Information for competent set players wanting to play in a team:

Team age groups: 10 & Under through to 16 & Under

Team requirements:

- each team must have a team Manager.
- players must be at competent set playing level but do not have to be champion players.
- players are expected to support the team by playing a full season.**
- note: the Club is fined for unrepresented teams & late placement of score cards.

Eligibility to play:

Players must be of the specified age as of March 14th 2010, and be a member of the Tennis Club.

Times of play:

Sunday mornings 8.30 a.m.- approx. 12.30 p.m. and practice on Thursday afternoons from 4.45 p.m.- 5.45 p.m.

Team Practice:

First practice will be held on Oct 15th. Note: practice sessions over the Christmas break when there is no pennants will be optional. It is important that players attend team practice as this is when the Captain organizes their team for the coming Sunday. Team Managers are encouraged to oversee practice sessions of rallying and match play, as little coaching is given at this time. **We encourage players to enrol in professional tennis coaching classes to complement team practice sessions. See Marshalls Tennis Academy for details.**

Fees:

- Annual Junior Membership of East Fremantle Lawn Tennis Club is \$72.
- Summer Junior Club, run by Marshall's Tennis Academy, and Junior Pennants are all covered under the one fee of \$75. This fee includes team entry fees and ball fees.

Junior Club and pennant players must be a member of the tennis club.

Adult Team Manager role (Parent):-

Every team must have a Team Manager. Teams are not eligible without a Team Manager. The Team Manager's role is to liaise with the Captain (one junior member of the team), oversee the team, organize transport for away games (usually by rostering with the other parents) and enter home match results via the internet. One team manager will also play the role of Match Supervisor for home games, although Scott Marshall will be at the Club to assist with this role.

Team Captain Duties:-

The Team Captain oversees the team and makes sure that he or she has organized a full team each week.

Note: the club is fined if teams are not fully represented.

Dates of play:

October - 25th
November- 1st, 8th, 15th, 22nd, 29th
December- 6th
February- 7th, 14th, 21st
March- 7th (Semi Finals), 14th (Finals)

Team Numbers:-

The team has four players playing each week but each team needs a minimum of five players. Teams will rotate the players to ensure each player gets a chance to play.

Pennant fixture books:-

Tennis West usually brings the fixtures out just days before the start of the competition and we will then hand on the information to Captains and players at the training session prior to the first playing date. All of the information required can be found on the Tennis West website:
